Who Is Eligible

Any dues-paying member in good standing may run for any officer position. Campus Rep candidates must be members at the campus they seek to represent.

Positions Available

District-Wide (all eligible members vote):

President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Secretary

Campus Representatives (members vote for their campus only):

- Daley College: 4 positions (54 eligible members)
- Kennedy-King College (including DTI): 2 positions (24 eligible members)
- Harold Washington College: 6 positions (102 eligible members)
- Malcolm X College: 3 positions (43 eligible members)
- Olive-Harvey College: 2 positions (25 eligible members)
- Wright College: 5 positions (85 eligible members)
- Truman College: 4 positions (69 eligible members)
